Glenn P. Johnson III was born April 13, 1965 in Connellsville State Hospital in Connellsville, PA. He is the son of Glenn P. Johnson, Jr. & Carole George Johnson.

His dad was the scoutmaster of Troop 155 for St. John the Baptist Church in Scottdale, Pa. As you can see, Scouting was a part of his life from the beginning. Visiting Camp Conestoga, scout meetings, and outings were always part of his life. He joined Cub Scout Pack 155 in Scottdale when he was 6 years old. After getting his Arrow of Light, he “crossed over the bridge” to join Troop 155. His family moved to Greensburg in the summer of 1977.

That fall, he became a scout in Troop 480 at St. Paul Parish. Our first Sunday as parishioners at St. Paul’s we learned that Glenn’s grandmother, a teacher at St. Paul Grade School, had volunteered his father to be the new Scoutmaster.
